## ADVENT SEASON

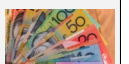
Next weekend we will be commencing a new liturgical year, Advent season. During the Advent Season families should spend time together preparing for the approaching celebration of the birth of Christ. An Advent Wreath can be a great focal point for family prayers and holiday celebrations. The Advent wreath is a wreath of laurel, spruce or similar foliage with four candles that are lighted successively in the weeks of Advent to symbolize the light that the birth of Christ brought into the world. Traditionally three of the candles are purple, the colour of the kings and penance. A rose-colored candle is used to mark the Third Sunday of Advent as a time to rejoice over the closeness of Christmas and the coming of Christ.
